

## Rights and Privileges Attributed to Unratified Societies

### **1. Interpretation**

Any Society of Hull University Union that has not been recognised by Council for any reason is deemed to be un-ratified. Until the time that Council grants recognition, the Society will not be permitted to have the same rights or privileges as a recognised Society of Hull University Union.

### **2. Rights and privileges of un-ratified Societies**

Under the discretion of Council and the Union Executive Committee, any un-ratified Society has:

- The right to book without charge any of the Union rooms that are available. However, priority will lie with recognised Societies.
- The right to book tables in the Union foyer, subject to the correct monies being paid.
- The right to book poster space and advertise meetings for free in the Student Union building, subject to them being placed in designated areas.
- The right to book mini buses, subject to the completion of the relevant booking forms, having an authorised driver and a deposit being paid prior to departure.
- The right to public announcements over the tannoy system provided the content is agreed to by VP Community and a member of Hull University Union staff makes the announcement.
- The right to a stall at the Societies Bazaar
- The right to attend Societies meetings and the right to be informed about all issues affecting Societies.
- The right to obtain support and guidance from the Students' Union.
- The right to Societies training
